We are pleased to announce the selection of Bill Beaumont as the Director of the National Jamboree and Outdoor Events effective May 12, 2025. Bill brings over 15 years of Scouting leadership experience to the role.

Bill began his Scouting career in 2009 with the Inland Northwest Council, where he served as District Executive, Senior District Executive, District Director, and Camping Director. During his time as Camping Director, he played a vital role in enhancing camp operations and program delivery, contributing to the growth and success of the council's outdoor programs.

In 2016, Bill was selected as the Executive Director of the Irvine Ranch Outdoor Education Center for the Orange County Council. There, he led a \$3.1 million property operation serving more than 42,000 participants annually. Under his leadership, the center saw significant growth in both program engagement and financial sustainability, with a strong focus on program innovation, property management, and staff development.

In February 2020, Bill joined the Chief Seattle Council as Director of Support Services where he currently serves. In this role, he provides leadership to a diverse portfolio that includes seven council properties. During his tenure, annual camping revenue increased from \$1.8 million to \$2.6 million, expanding access and opportunities for youth and families across the region.

Bill is an Eagle Scout with two palms, a Vigil Honor member of the Order of the Arrow, and has served as both a participant and staff member at the National Jamboree. He and his wife Kristina enjoy running, cycling, and exploring National Parks with their daughters Savannah, Mackenzie, and Sage, and their dog, Beau.

Bill is eager to lead and support the National Jamboree team and committee to finalize planning for and then delivering a mountaintop Jamboree experience for each participant in 2026.

Bill will report to Tom Pendleton, National Director of Outdoor Programs and Properties and will be based in Irving, TX.
